Overview: The Kids' City Director ensures the families of The District Church have a safe and fun environment where children can learn to know and follow Christ. The Director works with families with children (infants - 5th grade) in partnership with their parents/guardians and our volunteers. This role involves collaboration with other ministry teams to provide opportunities for our children to nurture their gifts and skills as they live out their God-given mission. Kids' City seeks to provide a discipling environment where children are able to hear the gospel, see the gospel lived out, and be invited into a relationship with Christ. Additionally, this area of ministry is designed to equip parents to be the primary disciplers of their children and the bridge to the youth ministry.

About The District Church: The District Church is a thriving, culture-defining church in the heart of our nation's capital, with a vision of impacting our City for Christ, one neighborhood at a time. Established on the values of worship, community, and justice, the church is steadfast in being missional, multicultural, and multiplying.

- Oversee the Sunday Kids' City experience.
- Manage the recruitment and onboarding process of all volunteers. Complete all background checks and applications for volunteers.
- Equip and train volunteers with age-appropriate teaching techniques and knowledge of engaging with parents.
- Collaborate with other ministries in the church to fulfill the mission of discipling children and families.
- Ensure that our data management in our church system is regularly updated.
- Oversee the system to welcome and follow up with new families to the church.
- Oversee the process of welcoming newborns and the execution of regular baby dedications.



• Plan regular events for children, parents, and volunteers to help strengthen the ministry.
