Throughout the year of 2011, workshop training sessions have been held for new volunteer teachers of ESL. Skills and methods are taught to prepare teachers for the classroom. All teachers are given opportunity to practice what they have learned. A very comprehensive manual filled with ideas and instruction is used as a guide.

The manual, **TEACHING ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS THE GOOD NEWS**, tasks ESL teachers to not only teach English, but to share the Good News of Jesus Christ through word and deed. Teachers are encouraged to **LIVE** Christ before their students.

During January through April of this year, more than 68 new teachers have taken workshops. They join more than 600 others who have taken ESL teacher training through NorthStar Church Network in the last 8 years.
